Manuscript Structure

All submissions, except commentaries or book reviews, should follow the structure below.

Title page:

This should include the title of the article, full names of authors, institutional affiliations, ORCID iDs if available, and the corresponding author's email and phone number.

Declarations

Declare any conflicts of interest.

Abstract:

Maximum of 300 words following the structure of Background>Methods>Results>Conclusion

Introduction: Provide a concise abstract of no more than 300 words, which should briefly introduce and state the purpose of the research.

Methods: Briefly state the methods relevant to the results included in the abstract

Results: Briefly state the sample size and the principal results

Discussion/Conclusion: Briefly state the major conclusions of the work and its relevance.

Keywords

Provide 3-6 keywords. and avoid general and plural terms, and multiple concepts. Avoid the use of conjunctions (e.g., and) and abbreviations. Write keywords in normal text.

Main Text

Introduction: Background of the study, problem statement, and objectives.

Methods: Describe study design, participants, use of study tools, procedures, and data analysis. Include informed consent and also ethical approval if applicable.

Results: Present findings clearly using tables and figures where necessary. Number tables and figures sequentially (Table 1, Figure 1) and insert them within the manuscript near the point of reference. Provide clear titles, captions, and legends for tables and figures.

Discussion: Interpret the results with reference to existing literature. Do not repeat your results section.

Conclusion: Summarize major insights, implications, and recommendations.

Acknowledgements: Optional

Authors' Contribution: Following the CRediT system. Click [here](#) for more information on the author's contributions. Gift authorship is not permitted.

References: Use APA 7th edition. References should be single-spaced and arranged alphabetically.

Submission Process

Manuscripts should be mailed to info@umerfacad.org along with the vetting fee receipt.

Peer Review Policy

A double-blind peer-review system is used, with two expert reviewers per manuscript.

Review duration is about 1-4 weeks.

Plagiarism Policy

Any manuscript with a similarity index higher than 20% will not be sent out for review and will be declined for publication
